#### Clubs

All booking is completed on a first come first served basis by our Magic Booking software. This software maintains waiting lists for us to help remain fair. We do not offer trial spaces but will return to the payment wallet funds if a child does not attend the club for the set amount of weeks. Out of simplicity we charge for the full amount of weeks at once. We have lunchtime clubs on offer free of charge and there is **no need to** book these on Magic Booking.


