Dear Parents and Carers,

Again a huge thank you to parents who are helping with the managing of cases in our school . It is heartening to know that we have so many supporters out there who cheerlead our every step and trust that we want the best outcome. Our surge is not uncommon across Bracknell and we know the change from PCR to LFT has been part of the explanation.

Thank you to all who are testing daily regularly when asked. The two YG at the moment asked to do this are currently Y6 and this can cease by Monday unless further asked and Y5 who started their 7 day monitoring today. By Y6 children being tested on Monday another 8 children tested positive and 10 more were found spotting symptoms at a lower level before they then became ill. We most likely have caught more asymptomatic cases this way and we haven't had to revert to online learning – a situation we have aimed to avoid as much as possible throughout this pandemic as we prefer children in learning 'face to face'.

I will, as always, remain transparent and honest in communication to you.

Anxiety: Understanding and Supporting your child/ young person Workshops for parents and carers



Experiencing some worry and anxiety is normal and common in people of all ages. However, there are times when worry and anxiety can feel very difficult to manage and

begins to impact on an individual's wellbeing as well as on their wider friends and family. The COVID-19 pandemic has brought many changes to our lives and for some children and young people this may have led to new worries and anxieties or added to some worries which were already present.

These workshops are designed to help you understand your child/ young person's anxiety and help you to explore strategies you can put in place to support them at home. They will also give you the opportunity to share with and learn from other parents who may be struggling with similar issues.






