

Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New year. It is so lovely to see so many people back with us.

We hope that anyone self isolating and recovering comes back to us soo. Some welcome news that you no longer have to seek PCR after a LFT result. 'Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result are to be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11th January. This will mean that anyone who receives a positive LFD test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test.'

In total this week we have 12 staff absent and no new cases. None of the children absent have been in school but we have over 30 children isolating at the moment. We will of course update you if *new* cases start to arise and if the 10% is reached with new cases but it is not necessary at the moment as these children haven't been in school!


