Homework

- If homework is repeatedly late or not completed there will be a phone call home to discuss any concerns or how we can support in school.
- Additional homework tasks will be available in the classroom if wanted (times table based)

- Given out on a Friday to be tested on the following Friday.
- 20 words to learn each week. These will differentiated where necessary.
- Words linked to the Year ¾ words set out in the national curriculum as well as any new words we are covering in class.
- Both classes would love to win the Spelling Bee award so all your help and support at home would be much appreciated!

Reading

- Reading books and reading records must be in school EVERY day.
- Children are encouraged to read at home every day.
- This must be recorded in their records and signed by someone at home at least 3 times a week.
- We would welcome any volunteers to hear readers, please have a chat with one of us if you'd like to help.

Snacks

- Make sure your child has a named water bottle in school every day.
- Ensure snacks for playtime are healthy and contain no nuts.
