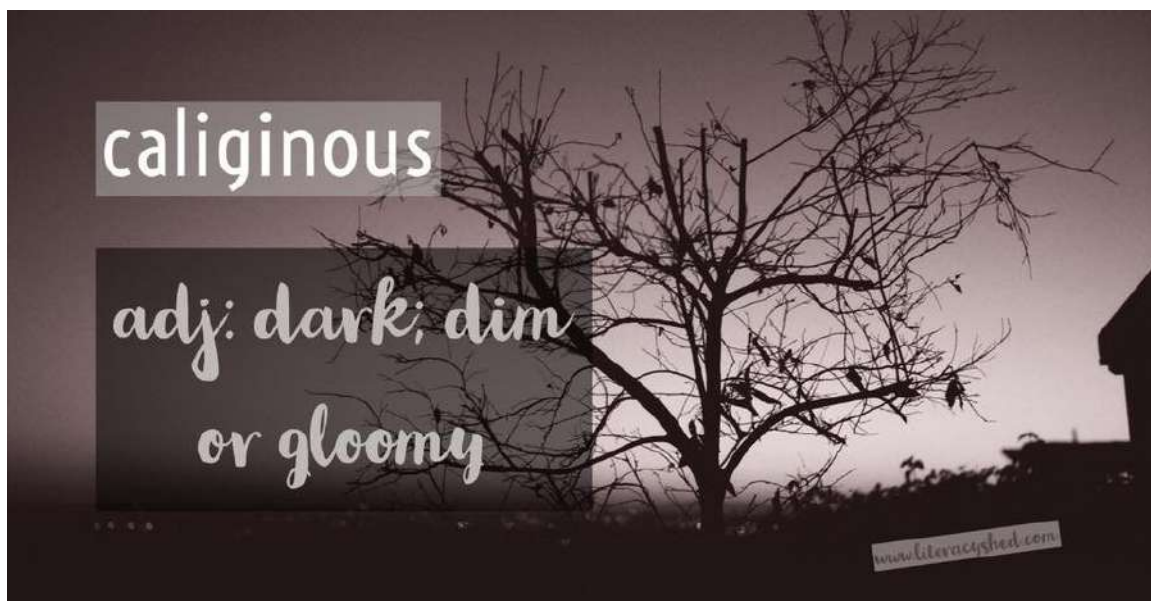


We have been busy
