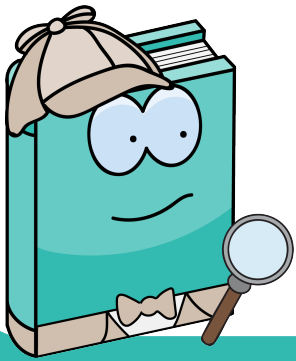
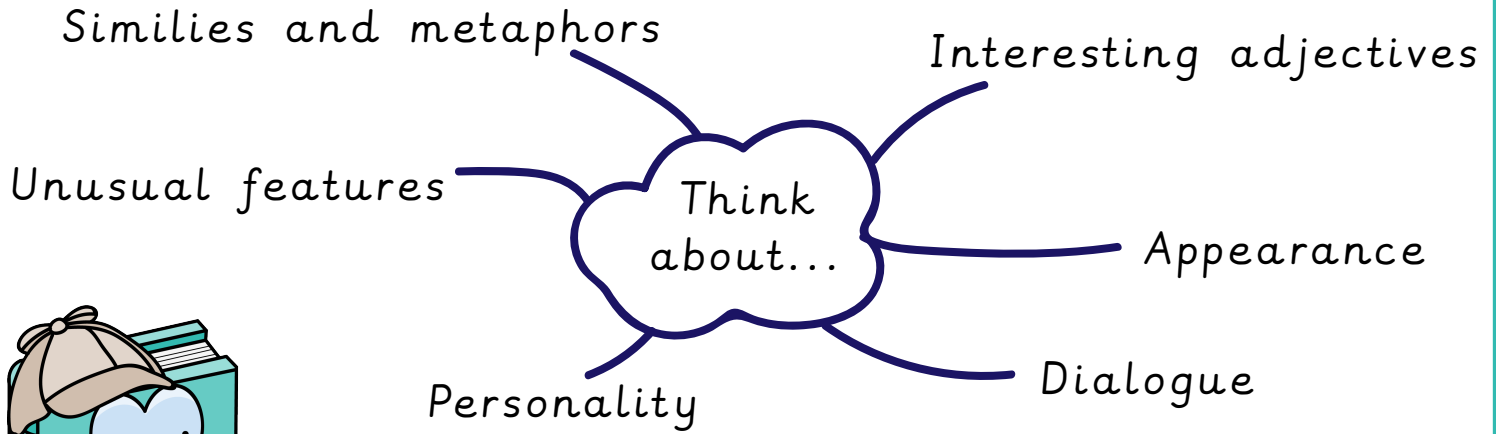


5 I've got your back!

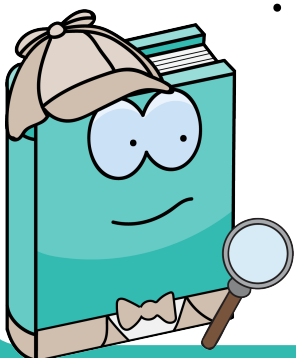
6 We have a problem!
