The message behind the craft is that “everything will be ok”.

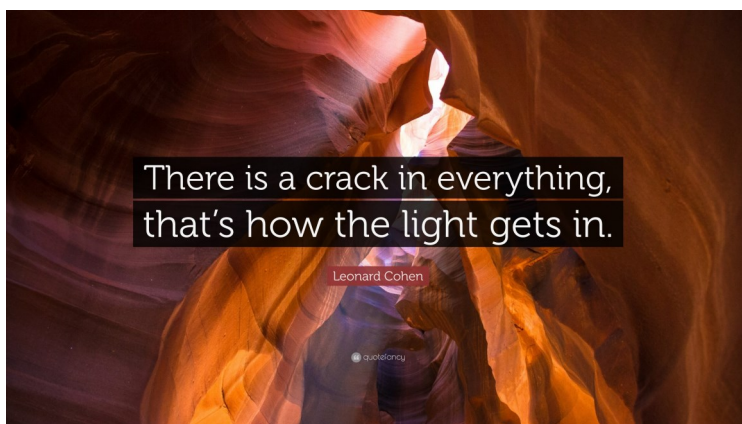
We would like to start this in Jennett's Park, focussing on rainbows. Rainbows signify hope, new beginnings and of course, makes up part of our school badge.
