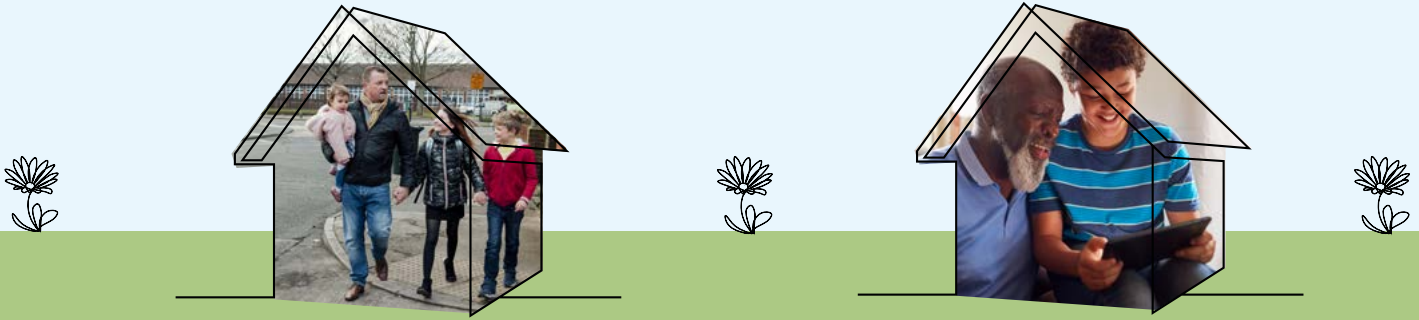


# Testing for school households



If you are a member of a household that includes school staff, early years or school age children, you can get a free twice-weekly test. This also applies if you are part of a support or childcare bubble to early years and school age children. This will help to stop the spread of COVID-19 through our community, as one in three people with COVID-19 do not have symptoms.

These tests can be carried out:

through your employer if they offer testing to employees

at a local Community Test Site

by collecting a home test kit from Bracknell Leisure Centre (daily between 1.30pm - 7pm)

by ordering a home test kit at GOV.UK

## Who is eligible?

School staff (early years, primary, secondary, college)	<b>Yes</b>	Twice weekly testing kits provided by school
Early years and primary school pupils	<b>No</b>	Testing is not required for early years and primary school children
Secondary school and college pupils	<b>Yes</b>	Twice weekly testing kits provided by school (following initial tests in school)
Households and support or childcare bubbles of all early years, primary and secondary school and college pupils	<b>Yes</b>	Twice weekly testing through <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Employer</li> <li>• Community Test Site</li> <li>• Collection from Bracknell Leisure Centre</li> <li>• Ordering for home delivery</li> </ul>
Households and support and childcare bubbles of all early years, primary and secondary school and college staff	<b>Yes</b>	Twice weekly testing through <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Employer</li> <li>• Community Test Site</li> <li>• Collection from Bracknell Leisure Centre</li> <li>• Ordering for home delivery</li> </ul>

## If anyone tests positive or gets COVID-19 symptoms, they should tell the school and:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• self-isolate immediately</li> </ul>	get a PCR test to confirm the result	follow the stay at home guidance for households with possible COVID-19 infection. Please do not attend any community testing, workplace testing or collection site if you have COVID-19 symptoms. If you have symptoms you must self-isolate immediately alongside your household and request a PCR test via GOV.UK.
