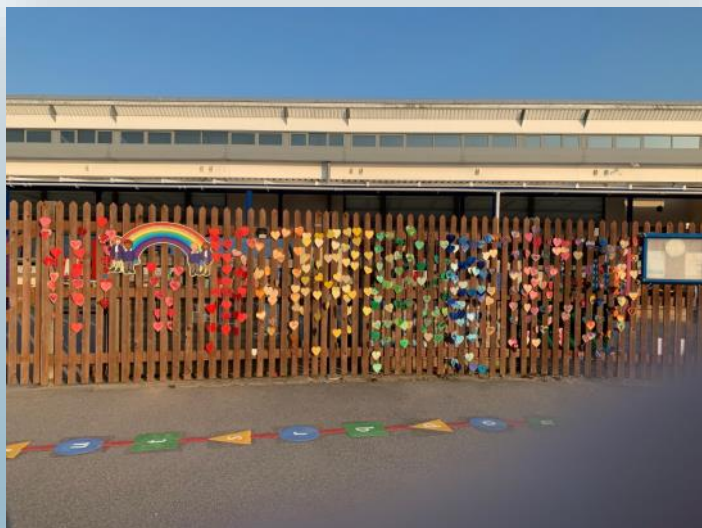

This year we are planning to still create our beautiful Christingle that the children will be taking home for their loved ones.

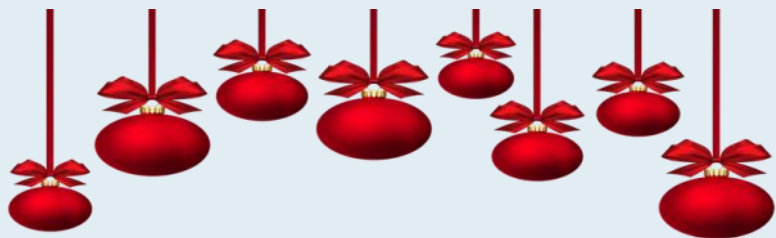
Please can each child bring an orange into school by Thursday 2nd December.

The session structure will be

11 – 11.15 recap for parents

Resilience is a child's ability to cope with ups and downs, and bounce back from the challenges they experience during childhood. Building resilience helps children not only to deal with current difficulties that are a part of everyday life, but also to develop the basic skills and habits that will help them deal with challenges later in life, during adolescence and adulthood.

This course is aimed at parents whose children find it difficult to "bounce back" from the challenges that they face at home or school. They may become angry, irritable or withdrawn when things don't go well.

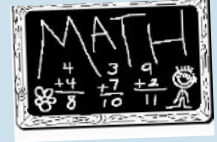

After a lay-led service and our open-air Remembrance Service we have Reverend Carol with us so will be running our usual cafe style church with Communion. Tables will be socially distanced but mixing will be allowed.

Adults should still wear masks. We shall be serving refreshments from 11:00 a.m. but everyone must be seated by 11:30 for the start of the service. Anyone arriving after this time will not be able to gain access. Please fill up the tables from the front, use the hand sanitiser by the front and login to the venue using the Covid App and QR code.

This week is the Sunday Next before Advent and we shall be celebrating the festival of Christ the King. The reading is from Saint John's gospel and I attach it if you would like to prepare to read. This Sunday is also known as Stir Up Sunday as traditionally you make your puddings ready for Christmas. The name comes from the Post Communion Prayer which begins "Stir up, O Lord,"

School signing for entry to Ranelagh and Saint Michael's has recommenced at the end of the service for those who have attended.

If you have signed up to help set up please arrive by 10:30. The sign up sheets are working well but could each family only sign up for one activity.
