## Green Jays and Parakeets

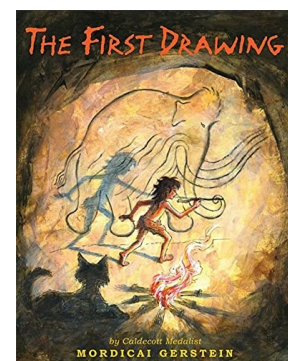
### Green Jays and Parakeets
