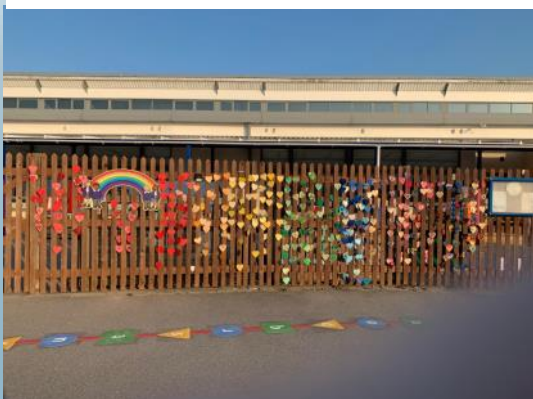

Dear Parents and Carers,

Holiday Club / 3-4 year old provision

We have contacted several providers to begin the process of a longer term solution for both our 3-4 year old care and Holiday Clubs. We have not been able to secure this for October or December but are hoping to give you more details for an Easter launch. Thank you for your patience– this is something we do not have to host but in the current financial climate we want to resolve to help as many parents and carers as possible. We will continue to signpost any providers on our Wraparound care page.

Trips and visits

As our offer of trips and visits begins again do please note that all trips are voluntary but sadly we are unable to subsidise everyone.

We do our best to divert funds from Sports Premium and Pupil Premium as much as possible but your supporting of our PTA or via clubs and wraparound care is vital. We set a 95% donation but those who are on Pupil Premium do not need to pay unless they feel they can make a donation. There is no spare pot of money sadly.

Last year we had many anonymous donors come forward to subsidise with amounts of funding to help the year group. 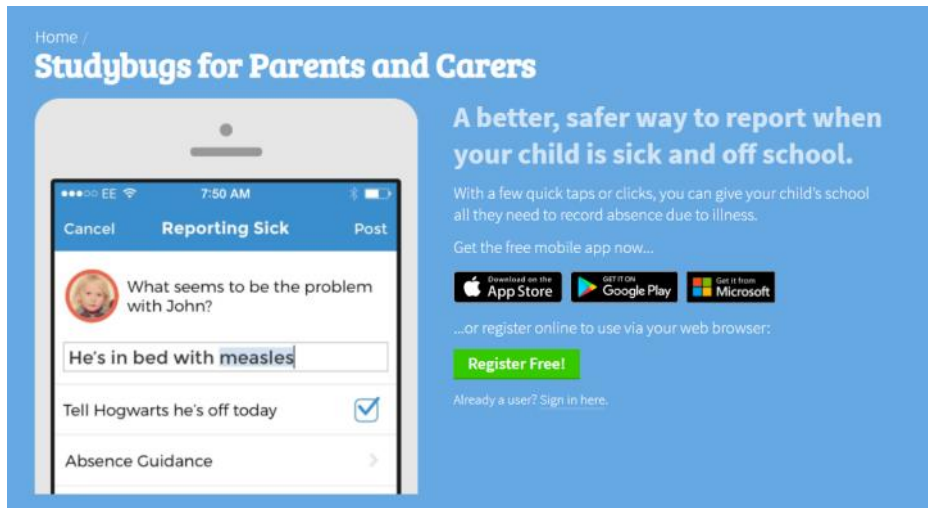

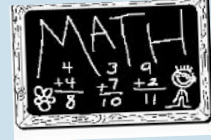

To prevent the health professional from sending messages to you, text STOP to our number. Messages are charged at your usual rates.
