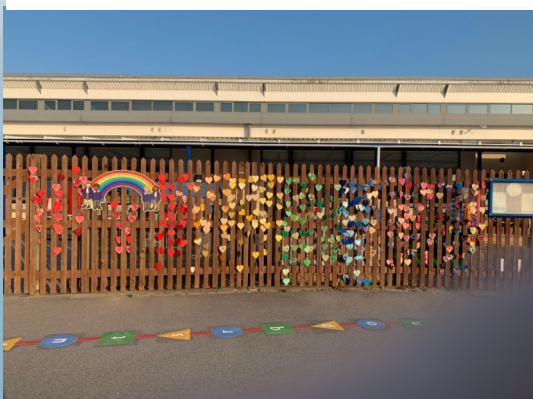

Opportunities to learn an instrument



We have [Rocksteady](#) coming into school on Thursday 24th November to do a launch performance for Years 1-6. They are a company that work in many schools and who teach children to learn an instrument while playing as part of a pop band. During the session on Thursday, we will watch a performance from their musicians, learn about each of the instruments (electric guitar, keyboards, drums and vocals) and what it entails to play as part of a band. At the end of the day your child will bring home further information about the costs and how the sessions would run should they be interested.

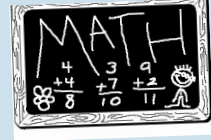
