Each week children are chosen for showing Owl learning behaviours or following our Rainbow Promise.

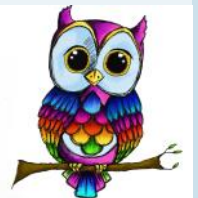
Our Rainbow Promise underpins everything we do

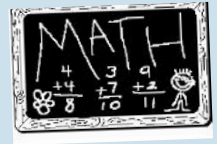
