There are still Easter holiday sessions available for [Camp Beaumont](#)— we have spaces for our 3-4 year olds too!

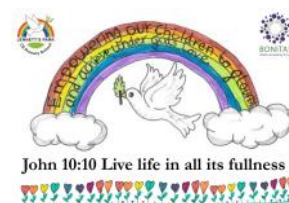

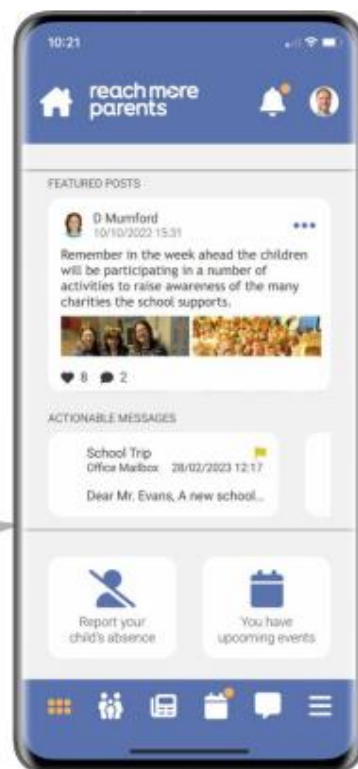
