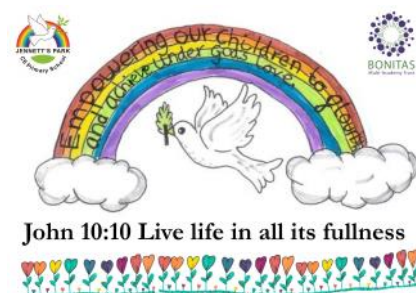

Y5 Residential

On the 16th April, children from Year 5 visited Oakwood Climbing centre for a mini residential.

High ropes (also called The Leap Of Faith) is a very tall obstacle, Year 5 were able to climb it safely by being attached to harnesses and having the rope part of the harnesses being held by the teachers and their classmates.



This is the Leap Of Faith - you climb to the top then jump to the bars hanging on top.



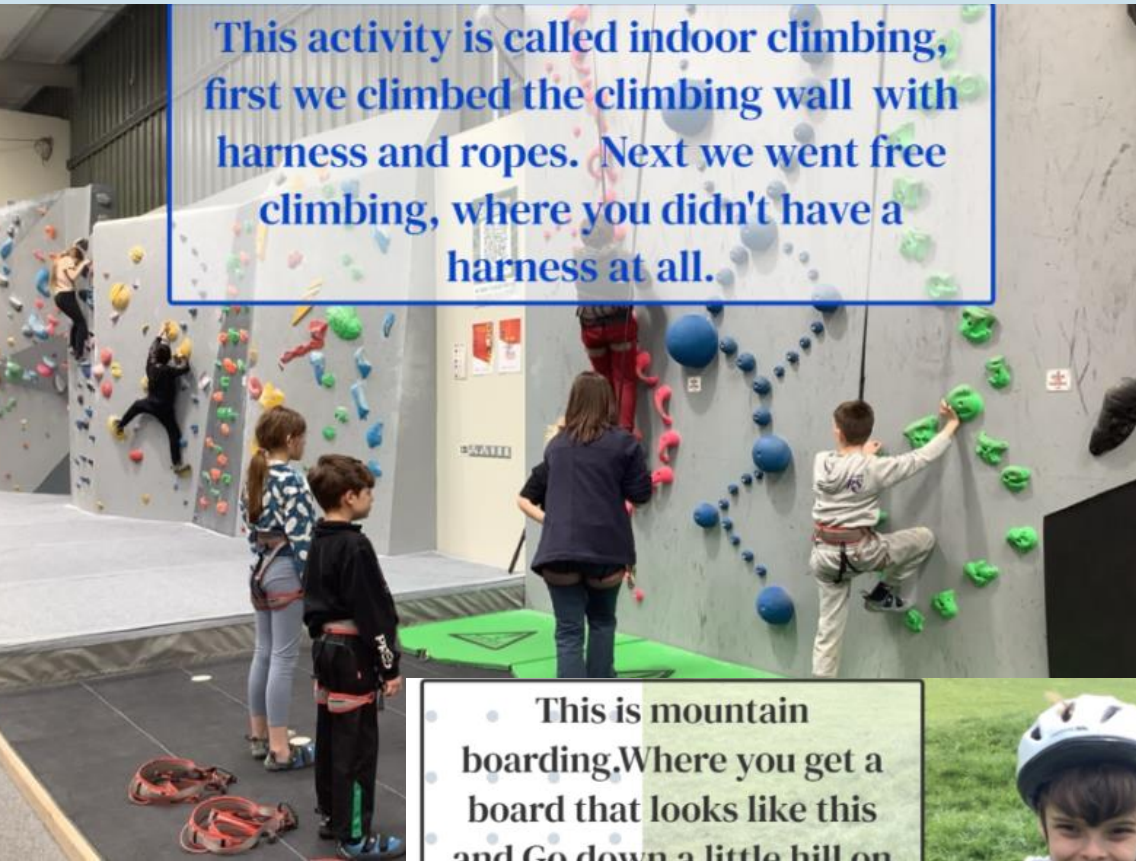
This is the ZigZag Logs. Year 5 would climb it in pairs and try to make it all the way to the top.

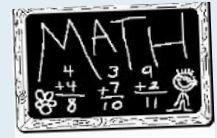

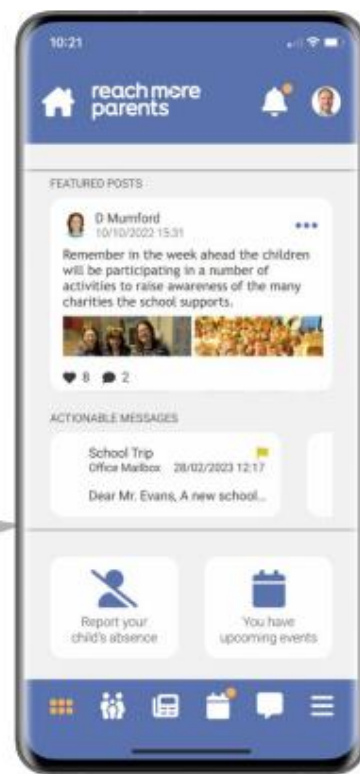
