or rugby) are returned to school.





#### RE: BilinguaSing clubs

We are now taking bookings for the autumn term of BilinguaSing lunch clubs at Jennett's Park CE Primary School.

'BilinguaSing' runs sensory bilingual music classes that stand out from the usual language clubs on offer and our 'On y Va!' and ¡Vamos!
