Secondly, we have been sponsored by Bracknell Leisure for free swimming in January Adopt a school free swimming | Jennett's Park (bonitas.org.uk)


Thirdly, we are launching 3–4 year old spaces for Nightowls in wraparound in January- After School Activities | Jennett's Park (bonitas.org.uk)
