## Year 4 News

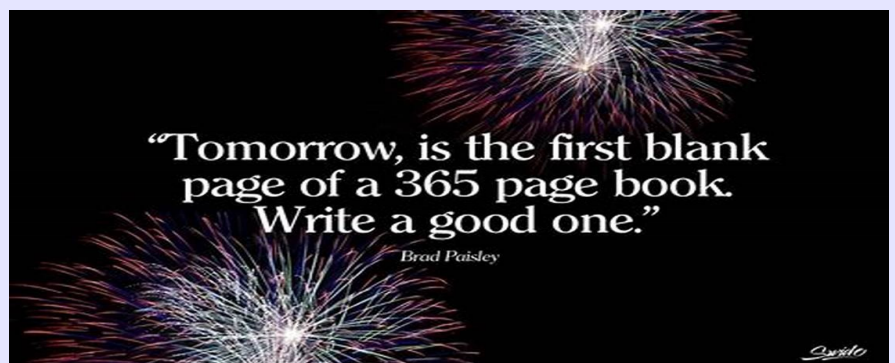
Happy New Year! We hope that you had a good Christmas break and are all refreshed and ready for an exciting start to 2024!
