#### **Inclusion Team**

25% of our children at Jennett's Park have an identified SEND. 6% of our school have EHCP's which is almost double the national average. If your child is on the SEND register, you should expect a copy of your child's learning plan over the next week or so. Invitations for these children to attend a SEND parents meeting will follow after this. Your child's class teacher remains the best placed person to contact regarding your child hence we give additional time for teachers to attend these meetings.

For those with EHCP's the best person is still your child's class teacher. All EHCPs and teaching strategies are overseen by Mrs Robinson and Ms Szadowski. All children with an EHCP will have an annual review within a term specific to your child.


#### PS Card machine.




