

Morning drop off Q & A

Why are we trialling a return to coming in via classes?

We think it will be a quicker and smoother start to the day. Teachers and adults in classes can greet and get things sorted quickly.

Can I come into the class as a parent?

No, whilst that might seem comforting please stay at the door to settle and quickly say goodbye. Smooth drop offs are important to start a day. Be sure to discuss this change with your children.

Will more gates be open?

Yes, the front gate and goodbye gate (near Y4) will be open. We will trial opening the back gate (near MUGA) later on.

Will the gates be open longer?

The front and side gates still close at 9:02. Any late arrivals need to enter via the school office.

Do parents have to drop to doors?

No, from year 3 we expect that they can walk around (you can walk round if you wish). Year 1-2 you may stop at big wooden Dance and Sensory gate to say goodbye if you find this easier.

Can I talk to the teacher/ an adult at a door?

We continue to ask you to save this at the end of day. Only urgent messages should be passed on at drop off. The maths is 30 x 1 minute conversations means 30 minutes. Messages need to be swift or remain as emails or coming to the office to make sure teaching time is maximised and the day begins promptly.

What if we're late?

Send children in via the office entrance and side gate after 9am rather than walking round.

Can my child continue to walk in via the entrance?

Yes. It will be covered too as I know some would still prefer coming in this way!

FIRST LEGO TEAM THROUGH TO NATIONALS

Sarah (Year 4) has recently joined a <u>FIRST LEGO</u> League team led by her older sister and has been awarded champion of the London NW Regional Tournament held at Bosch office on 15th March. This earned her team a place in the National Finals taking place in April at Harrogate Convention Centre.

FIRST LEGO League Challenge is a worldwide research and robotics tournament for 9-16 year olds. Every year, the teams need to construct and program an autonomous robot, and work on an innovation project related to the theme of the year. The challenge focuses on FIRST's core values of respectful interaction, shared experience, critical thinking, and most importantly having fun. After several weeks of preparation, teams participate in a regional competition and present their work to the judges in the categories of Innovation Project, Robot Design and Core Values. Teams will also compete against other teams in very exciting and spectacular robot games. The winner of every regional tournament will qualify to the Great Britain National Finals with a chance to represent Great Britain at an international stage.


