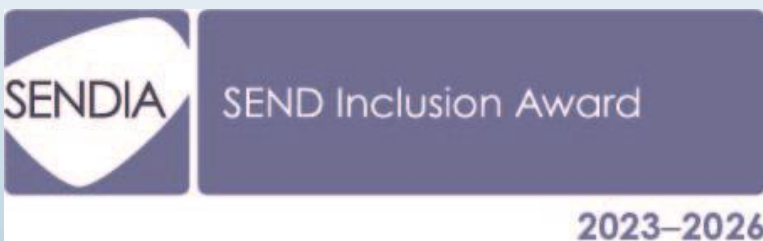

Examples you might want to come and chat with us about

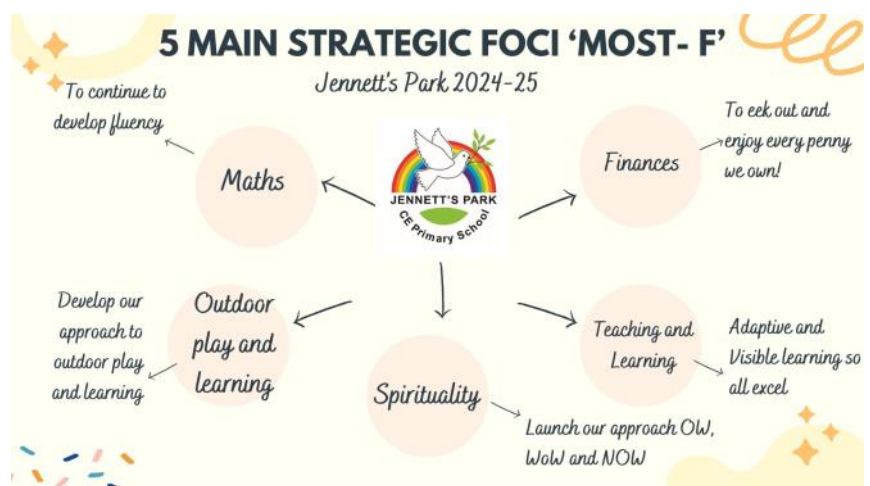
- What is happening in my child's year group?

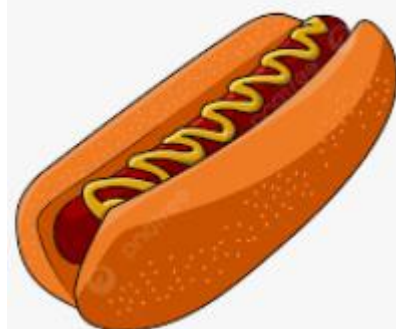

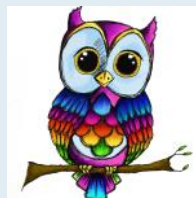
