There are lots of events and activities that we'd like to invite you in to- the first is for a belated VE Day party/ picnic we're having on Friday 9th May. Children and adults please come in that day dressed in red/ white and blue. This is a chance to have a low-key gathering with your friends, family and neighbours. Getting on with each other, living life in all its fullness and flourishing and achieving are so important. We are stronger woven together.

During that day/ week children will have had time to make some snacks and treats but extra donations would be welcome if labelled carefully for allergens!

At 2pm we'll head outside for a picnic on the grass. Like with our sports days you can collect children to sit with

We'll head children back in for 3:00 for the end of day but families are welcome to stay on playing on the field and recollect children from Y1 – 6 from rooms.
