Well done to Mrs Lant and the School council for earning us Gold Rail Safety standard!


VE day picnic – a reminder to come and celebrate with us next Friday afternoon. So many people saying they can come! Keep doing the rain dances.

Birdworld / ParentPay and Trips

We are sorry to those families who were frustrated this week. We apologise to everyone (including staff!) that we sadly had to cancel this trip with the hope of arranging next academic year.

We know quite a few of you were understandably upset by the decision to cancel without a 'chase' email being sent beforehand, as you were sensibly waiting for payday. We are very sorry for this. The decision was carefully considered and we are fairly equipped to estimate response rates and uptake to reminder emails and paydays. Unfortunately on this occasion we had such low initial uptake we were unable to commit financially to our providers with confidence we would make anywhere near the 95% threshold for voluntary contributions required for the trip to proceed. The outstanding balance two days before the payment deadline was in excess of £6,000 and the decision was made we were not able to absorb this risk or low payment.

Trips are always somewhat tricky to manage and while we are learning our own way around the behind-the-scenes of ParentPay to make it better for parents we do really appreciate your patience.

Refunds for Birdworld

Birdworld is the first trip we had needed to refund via ParentPay and we have realised that any future cancellations need to be processed slightly differently. Parents will begin to receive their refunds by Year Groups with the addition of children receiving PPG having been refunded. The office will be working through these a year group at a time as quickly as possible. You will receive a notification when you log into ParentPay once the refund has been made.
