Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to inform you of our intention to visit Legoland Windsor with Year 6 on **Wednesday 16th July,** as an exciting part of our ongoing STEM learning. The children will experience an exciting STEM workshop with Legoland builders in addition to exploring the park and enjoying a picnic. This is a very exciting opportunity and we are delighted to be able to take the children this year.

We will travel to Legoland by coach at 9:15am and are due to arrive back to school at **4:30pm**. Please do arrive on time for morning registration as the coach will be unable to delay leaving. We will require parent volunteers to help us to maintain a safe child to adult ratio.

Your child can pre-order a school packed lunch and the options for which wrap they would like are given below on the return slip. Alternatively, please provide your child with a packed lunch from home in a disposable bag.

We would like to request a voluntary contribution of £26.61* for this individual activity. This has been set up for you to pay through ParentPay and the payment to be made by Friday 31st May. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough voluntary donations by this date we will be forced to cancel the trip.

*Merlin or Legoland Pass Holders

We understand many children may have a Merlin or Legoland Pass. If your child has a Pass valid on 16th July you are able to:

- Pre-book their ticket and send their barcode and evidence for correct date to secretary@jennetts.bonitas.org.uk before Friday 31st May.
- Ensure they bring their Merlin Pass on the day
- Purchase the reduced-price Merlin Pass Holder offer via ParentPay (cost covers coach and workshops) We cannot accept any responsibility for lost Passes. Due to Legoland's group bookings, any children that arrive without their Merlin pass will unfortunately not be able to be 'added' to the school party on the day.

Please note Legoland is a completely <u>cash-free</u> venue and cash is not accepted at any outlets or shops.

Please return the reply slip to the office and the voluntary contribution via ParentPay no later than Friday 31st May. Please ensure you select the correct offer on parent pay, depending on whether your child has a Merlin pass or not. If you select the wrong offer then your child will be refused entry at the park. If you have any issues accessing ParentPay or have any questions, please see the school office who will be happy to help.
