

What is the Online Safety Act?

The Online Safety Act 2023 is a set of laws introduced to protect children and adults online. Ofcom is the regulator for online safety in the UK, responsible for ensuring companies follow the new rules. As part of this role, Ofcom have designed the Children Codes of practice, which came into force in July



COMMUNICATION WITH SCHOOL



As we start the new school year, we would like to take the opportunity to remind our families of our <u>communication policy (available on our website).</u>

As our priority remains to teach the children, teachers are not always immediately available to meet or speak with parents.

The correct route of concerns is to speak to class teachers (you may book this via the office if the start/end of day is not long enough). If class teachers are unable to resolve issues after a few meetings then please make an appointment with your Phase Leaders, then SENDCO/Assistant Heads/Deputies or the Family Support Worker via the school office. Parents that demand an immediate appointment may not be accommodated, this would be the same in any school or indeed doctors lawyers or dental surgeries.
