A very exciting update attached for all parents and carers regarding Bonitas and Oxford Diocesan Schools Trust. [Please find a copy here](#)


We'd like to remind everyone of the three foundations to our school.

1. Is it about:

- o Volunteering & Donations → email via secretary us to know how you can help or fill in the form <https://forms.office.com/e/nAFcD6SQPT>
- o Clothes/ donation requests → Come to Thrive on a Thursday

- o Clubs and wraparound provision → [After School Activities | Jennett's Park](#)
- o Child's learning, class issues, minor behaviour → take time to meet the Class Teacher. Often this is the fastest route!
- o Broader year group/phase issues or repeats of concerns over period of time → Phase Leader's are here to help
- o SEND concerns or support needs → Class teacher is your fastest route to help in class THEN SENDCo will help advise
- o Family or pastoral support needed → Family Support Worker is here to help you
- o Safeguarding, serious welfare, or child protection → Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) – if a child is at risk let us know
- o Escalated unresolved issues, or serious concerns → Deputy/Assistant Headteacher (or Headteacher, if needed)

2. How to contact:

3. What happens to emails sent to us?

- o School teams check inboxes daily
- o Queries are forwarded to the relevant staff member, based on the flow above/ redirects to right email
- o Staff member responds asap within agreed timeframe (3 working days is typical)

4. If unresolved:

- o Parent may escalate:
 - First to Phase Leader or relevant senior staff
 - Then to Deputy/Assistant Head
 - Finally, to Headteacher
