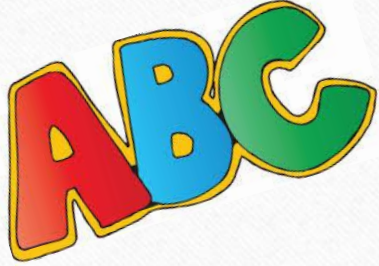
Days to remember in Year 1

- P.E day –Stonechats-Tuesday and Wednesday. Whinchats- Thursday and Friday.
- Book change day – Friday
- Library day – Stonechats – Friday. Whinchats - Thursday
Don't forget...
 - A named water bottle in school every day
 - A spare change of clothes/underwear (if required)
 - Reading books and reading records every day
 - School uniform labelled



Reading in Year 1

- Reading books and reading records **MUST** be in school **EVERY** day.
- Children take home 2 books each week. Please re-read these books with your children as this will help develop their fluency. 😊
- Reading books will be changed on a **Friday**.
- Children in Year 1 are expected to read at home **4** times a week, this is their homework.
- Please record when you have read with your child in their reading record, even just a date, book title and your initials please.



Phonics Screening Check

- Statutory government check takes place in June for all children in Year 1.
- Children read 40 words (20 real words/20 nonsense words).
- Check is completed on a 1:1 basis alongside the class teacher.
- All parents are informed of their child's pass mark at the end of the Summer term in their end of year report.
- Phonics home learning to support children for this check will be sent home on Seesaw in the Spring/Summer term.

Seesaw

- Used to share pictures of children's learning and work that they have completed.
- Home learning is added to Seesaw later in the school year.
- Reminders will be sent out for key events or if children need to bring any resources to school.
- You can post any learning or experiences that have occurred over the weekend or holidays if you wish.
- If you have any questions or would like to arrange a meeting with the Year 1 team, please email the office.

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- Just a reminder that all medications are to go through the office and not to be left in school bags. We are not allowed to take any medications through the door.
 - Lost property- unnamed will go to the office, named items will be delivered to classrooms.
 - In Year 1, we promote independence. Please encourage this anytime, anywhere!
 - Afternoon snacks – If you think your child can't last from lunchtime until bringing a snack at home time, please send a fruit or a vegetable. We will offer any leftover NHS School fruit and vegetables from morning until October half term to support transition. (Snacks **MUST** be either a fruit or a vegetable please.)
