Huge thank you to all who supported our Cake Sale. We are excited to plan out what equipment for children to spend monies on!



Everyone looked wonderful in their yellow outfits today as part of our focus on mental health awareness.




Children took part in mindful activities and also took time to reflect on how we can look after our mental well-being.
