We've enjoyed a wonderful first half term together in Reception. We have concentrated on 'having a go' and persevering with a task and then being able to feel proud of our efforts.

We read the story of 'The Rainbow Fish' and the children explored the story's characters, setting, problem and solution. We also broke the story down and looked at the structure, beginning, middle and end in detail.

We have been busy learning the first set of sounds in Phonics. We will complete the set now that we are back and continue to blend and segment short words to read and write. Later in the term, some of us will begin to learn the next set of sounds. In our writing we will begin to write short words and then link them together, writing two or three word captions e.g. 'the hot dog'. In our Maths learning we have been representing numbers to 3 in a variety of ways and have begun to look at one more and one less of a given number. We have recognised, continued and created our own repeating patterns.

We thought about the people who are special to us and explored our new school and the Rainbow Promise. The children pledged to show love, care and respect for each other as part of our class family, as well as trying hard to always do our best. We also explored the story of Noah's Ark, and discussed the Rainbow Promise God made to us. As always, if you have any comments or questions, please don't hesitate to come and see us.

Top Tips to Support Your Child This Half-Term

- 1. Practise putting on and taking off their coat independently including doing up zips and buttons.
- 2. Encourage your child to put on their own gloves (last!).
- 3. Continue to read with your child and practise their sounds as often as possible.
 - 4. Encourage your child to practise their name writing with the correct letter formation.
- 5. Praise your child if they have found something tricky as they are building their perseverance skills.
