5 Top Tips to Support Your Child This Half-Term

THINGS TO REMEMBER... Homework:

<u>Spellings:</u> Over the year, we are expecting children to learn the statutory spellings that will be posted on Seesaw, and to be using Spelling Frame for their weekly spelling test.

Maths: TT rockstars at least 3 x week for 15 minutes a time. If your child cannot remember their login, please let us know. We also encourage children to continue with their practice on Maths Whizz, throughout the week.

Reading: Your child will be expected to read for a minimum of 15 minutes a day, every week day. The adult at home should date and sign the bookmark to confirm that your child has read on that day.

P.E; Our PE days are Wednesday and Thursday. Please can children come to school in their PE kit.
