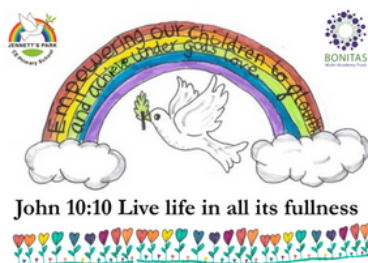

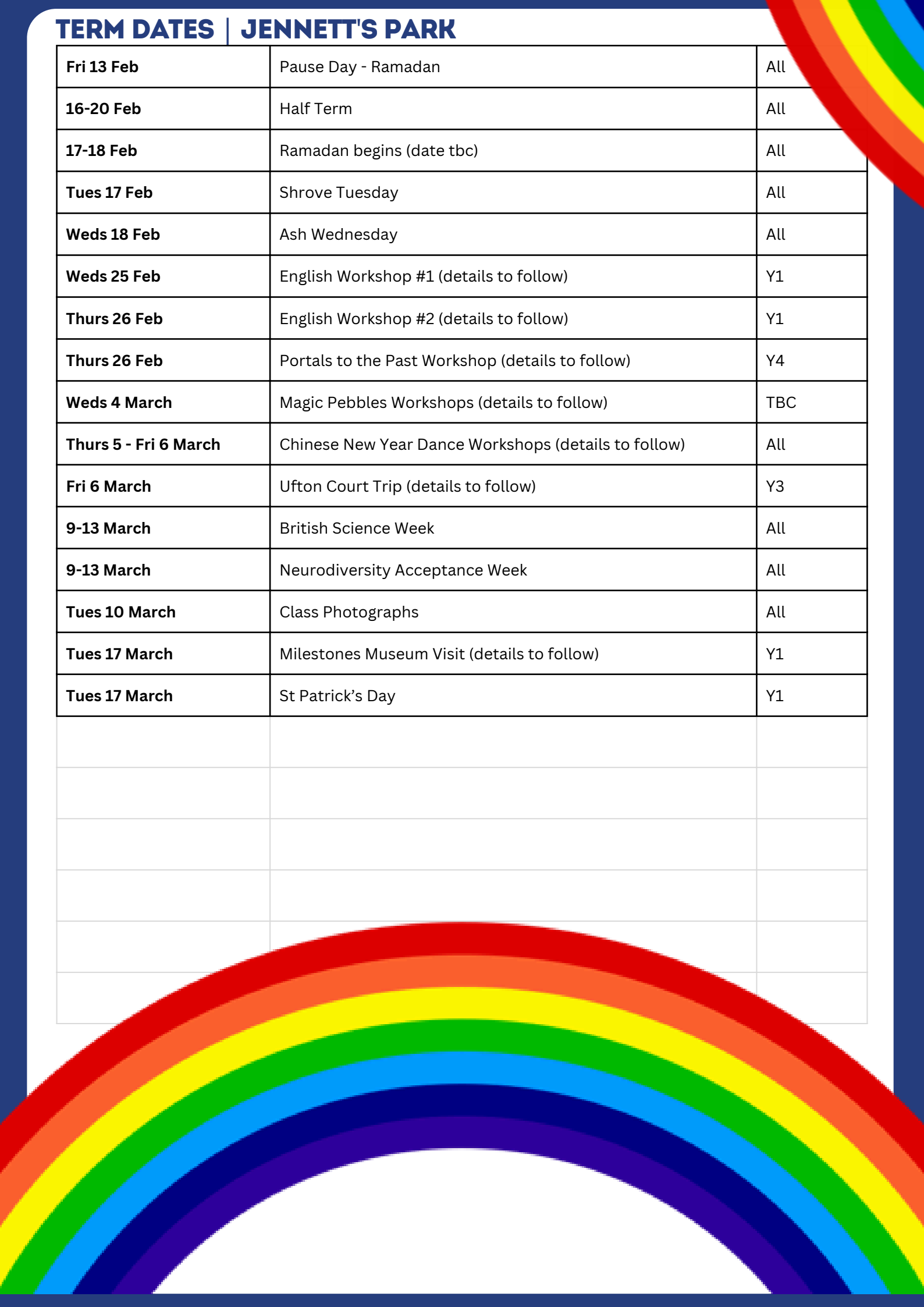

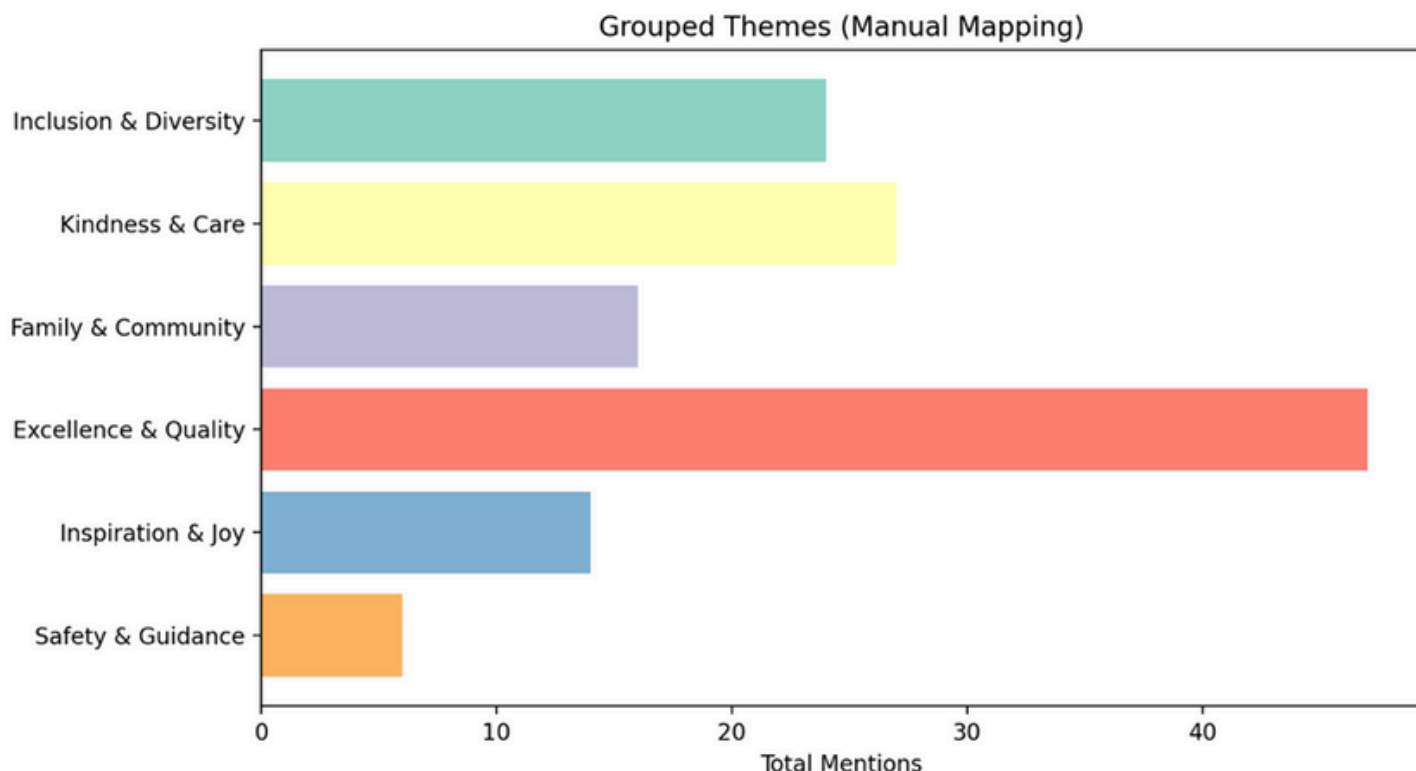

A family of Tawny Owls is depicted in the Sculpture, two adults in flight and three babies constructed in layered marine grade 316 stainless steel with anodised coloured stainless steel to emphasize the distinctive Tawny Owl plumage. As part of the engagement process Tim ran creative workshops at the Primary School for pupils to create their own owl designs.

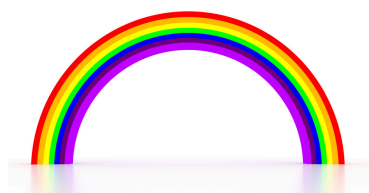

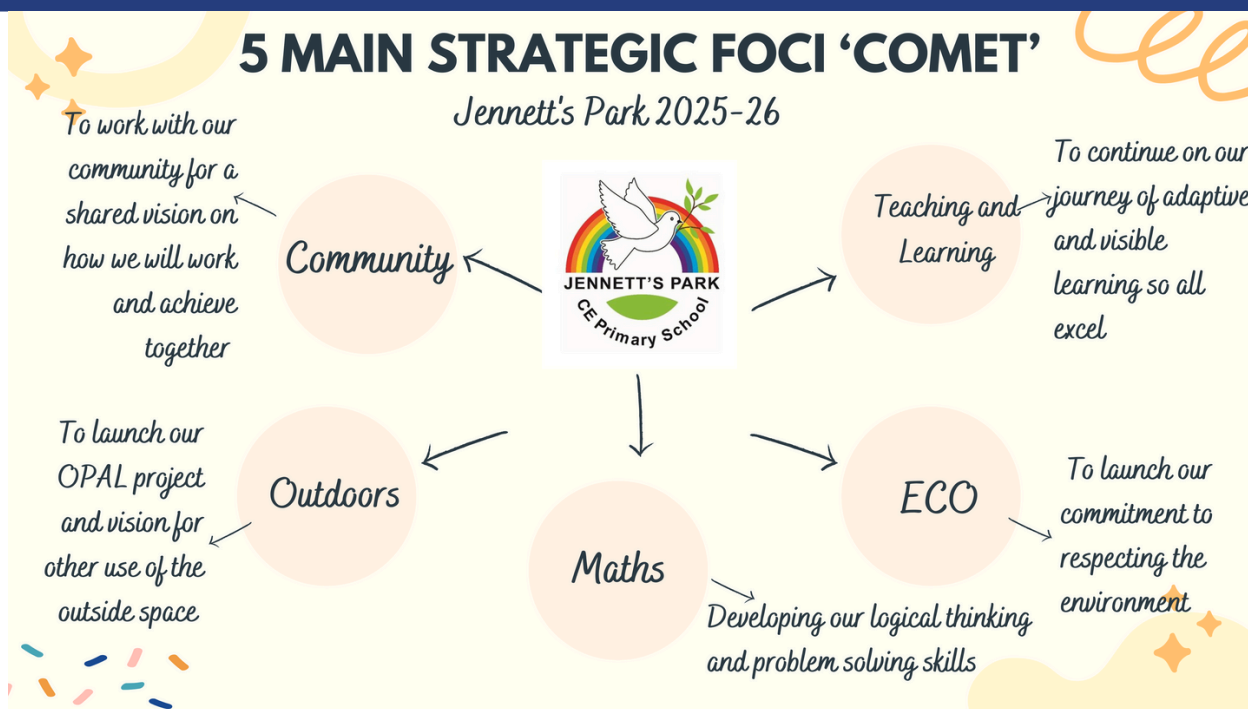

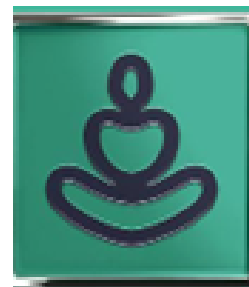
