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## Year 4 Sleepover

Dear Parents and carers,

We are delighted to confirm that we have organised a sleepover at school for the Year 4 classes. Inspired by our Explorers topic and closely linked to our new class book 'The Explorers', we will be stepping into the shoes of Fred, Con, Lila and Max who are stranded in the jungle after a plane crash. Like these characters, we will be learning how to navigate by the stars and identify potentially dangerous creatures.

The sleepover will be on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2026. Children should be picked up from school at the usual time, returning at 4:30pm in their own clothes. They will need to bring pyjamas, a washbag including a toothbrush and toothpaste, and a sleeping bag or quilt. They may also bring a sleeping mat and a pillow. Any airbeds should be brought to school already inflated. Children will be sleeping on the floor in the classrooms and will be responsible for looking after anything they bring with them. Soft toys are also welcome but please limit this to one per child (and possibly not an absolute favourite just in case).

We will provide a basic survivors dinner (jacket potato, hot dog and beans/cheese), making sure to cater for any specific dietary needs, but should you have any concerns about this please contact us via email. If children do not want to have this as their dinner, they are more than welcome to bring in a packed meal from home. We kindly request that children do not bring their own snacks or sweets as marshmallows/smores will be offered at the bonfire (vegan/halal will be catered to). Any sweets and snacks that are found will be collected by staff and returned to the child when they are picked up.

We would hope that all children will stay over to enjoy this experience as fully as possible, but any children not wanting to stay can still join in on the Friday evening and be picked up at 9pm. Teachers and other school adults will be staying overnight with the children and we ask that they are picked up promptly by 7:30am on the Saturday morning. We will not be providing breakfast.

In order to offer this trip, we need to ask for a voluntary contribution from each child of £10.00. This price covers the experiences booked and the cost of the food provided.

We are very excited at being able to give this opportunity to our children and feel strongly they will all benefit from this experience.
