Positive Choices Workshop Thursday 12th March 2026

Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to share with you that as part of our education curriculum on weapon and violent crime safety, we have been invited to a targeted youth event at Bracknell Forest Open Learning Centre on Thursday 12th March 2026.

This 'Positive Choices' event is being arranged and delivered by Thames Valley Police, Bracknell Forest Council Community Safety Partnership team, Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Services, Ambulance Services (TBC), Thames Valley Police, Youth Justice Services, and Story Group.

The content of the workshop includes basic life skills and personal safety advice as well as highlighting the risks of carrying a weapon and the repercussions should a child choose to do so. There will also be inputs in relation to online cybercrime and exploitation and an interactive Virtual Reality experience. Further details of this will be provided in due course.

Travel arrangements: To keep costs down we will be walking there and back. We will leave straight after morning registration at 9am and return by the end of the school day for 3.15pm.


