## International Week

We are excited to share that our annual International Week will take place from Monday 8th to Friday 12th June. This year's theme is the World Cup, giving us a fantastic opportunity to explore cultures from around the globe.

Throughout the week, all children (Nursery to Year 6) will take part in a range of engaging workshops focused on exploring the world around us and celebrating different cultures. These sessions will be delivered in partnership with Earth Song, helping to bring learning to life in a meaningful and interactive way.

To support the cost of these workshops, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£5.28** per child, payable via ParentPay or by card at the school office.

To conclude the week, on Friday 12th June we will be hosting a special Culture Day and hosting our very own World Cup Opening Ceremony. On this day, children are invited to come to school dressed either:

- In clothing that represents their culture or heritage (for example: traditional dress, national colours, or symbolic outfits), or
- In football kits to celebrate the diverse nations taking part in the World Cup

In addition, we will be running a class sweepstake across the school. Each class will be assigned three countries participating in the World Cup and will spend time learning about them during the week. If one of their teams goes on to win, the class will receive a special prize.

Children in Years 4, 5 and 6 will also have the opportunity to take part in a separate interactive workshop on Tuesday 16th June, led by Show Racism the Red Card.

This workshop titled 'Fans of the Future' will focus on empowering young people to play an active role as citizens in an increasingly multi-cultural society.

To enable this workshop to take place, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£5.58** per child (Years 4–6 only), payable via ParentPay or by card at the school office.
