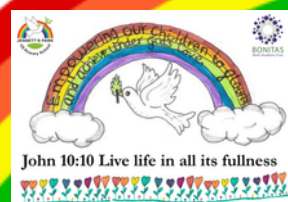

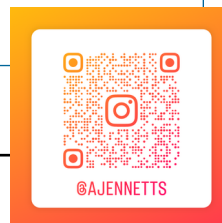

Over the past few years I have taken on single and multi-day off road mountain bike challenges; sometimes just for fun, sometimes raising money for charity.

This year I have two events planned to raise money for a personal cause, and I need your help to make a difference for a little boy called Onyx who we know through family friends.

Onyx was born with Moebius Syndrome, an extremely rare neurological disorder affecting fewer than 1 in 50,000 children.

Moebius Syndrome primarily affects his facial muscles but brings with it a number of other medical challenges including a cleft palate, webbed fingers, and clubfoot, all requiring multiple surgeries in the first two years of Onyx's life.

He has already undergone multiple rounds of full-leg casts, braces, and a tendon release procedure, but is now facing further surgery on his legs. Onyx and his family live in South Africa, where not all of the treatment he needs is covered.

The government has announced that social media platforms will be blocked from offering services to under-16s from next Spring. The ban will include platforms like Snapchat, TikTok, YouTube, Instagram, Facebook and X.

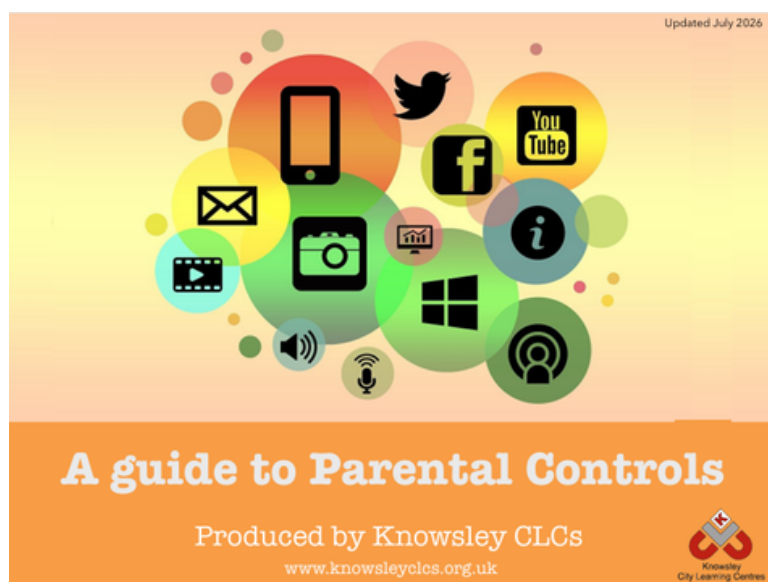

WhatsApp

We frequently receive reports of children using WhatsApp inappropriately, such as sharing images to embarrass others, sending hurtful messages, spreading rumours, or excluding people from group chats to make them feel left out. It is important to think about whether WhatsApp is the right platform for your child. For example, you should consider if your child has the critical thinking skills to recognise bullying and can they manage peer pressure and refrain from joining in on hurtful behaviour?

Users should be at least 13 years old to use WhatsApp. WhatsApp have announced that they are rolling out the option of Parent-Managed accounts for those under the age of 13. The settings will include allowing you to

Is your child entitled to free school meals?



Children who attend a Bracknell Forest school and whose parents or carers receive certain benefits, may be eligible to claim free school meals.

Free school meals are a good way to ensure that your child eats well at lunchtime, and you can save yourself time and money.

Plus, if you are eligible to claim free school meals your application will trigger extra government funding for your child's school. This funding is called Pupil Premium, and it will be invested in your child's school to improve educational outcomes.

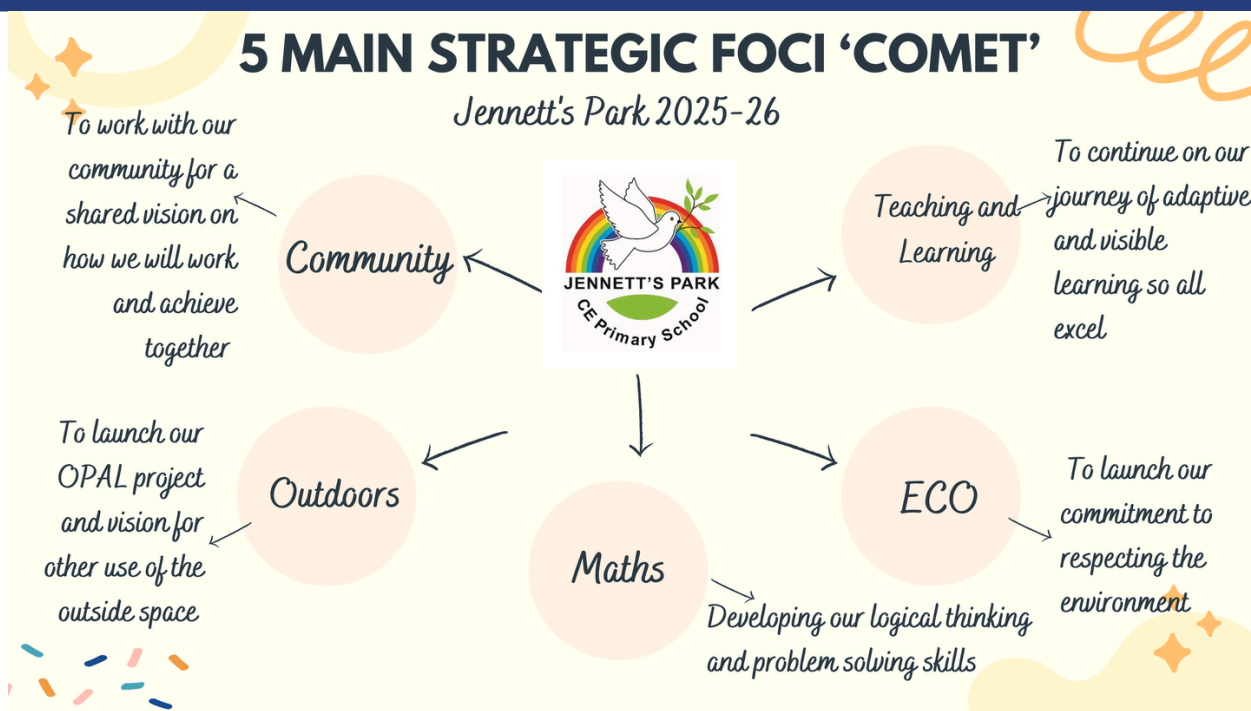

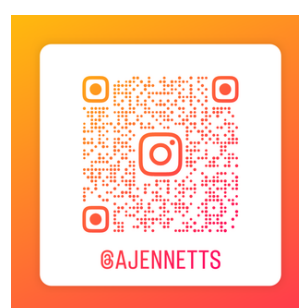
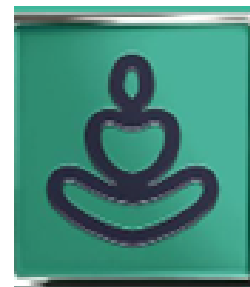
