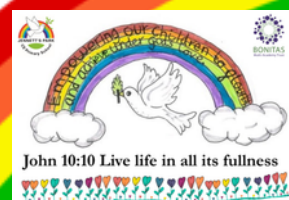
Remember the 5 best ways to help us are

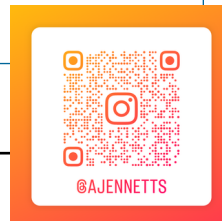

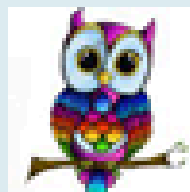

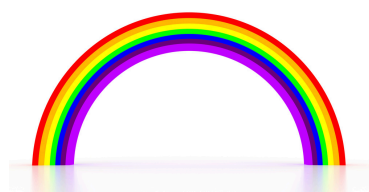

We are delighted to invite you to a special Year 6 Steel Pan Performance on Tuesday 14th July at 10:30am.

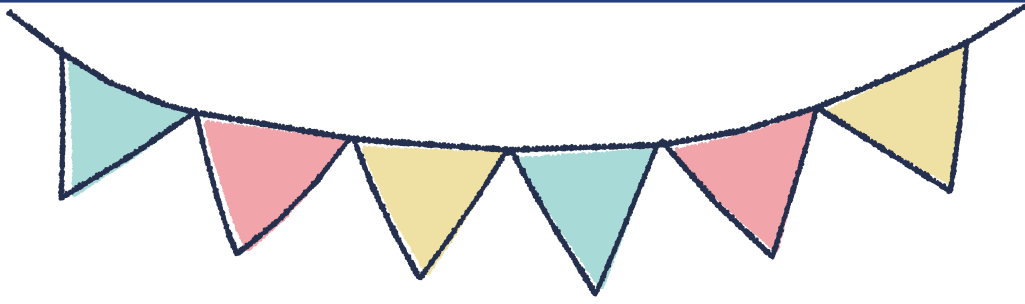

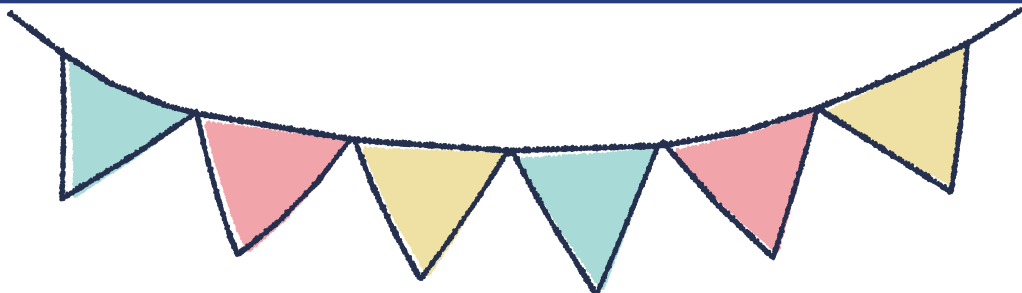


## **SPORTS DAY - R - 6**

# Is your child entitled to free school meals?



**Children who attend a Bracknell Forest school and whose parents or carers receive certain benefits, may be eligible to claim free school meals.**
